HIGH PRESSURE WASHING CONTRACT WITH TSTT

In November 2008, S.C.O.R.E. Limited was contracted by a local company to perform the high pressure washing, cleaning and chemical re-sealing of the concrete structure on the Telecommunication Services of Trinidad and Tobago (TSTT) Nelson Exchange building in Port-of-Spain.

This was S.C.O.R.E. Limited's first large high pressure washing maintenance project.

The project required a fair amount of pre-planning due to the building being in the proximity of the busiest area of down town. We had to source our own water for the project and had to provide large portable water storage tanks for the truck water tankers to continuously fill for the duration of the project.

We provided the man-lift, scaffolding and used our special Roemex (SCCB) concrete cleaner on the entire outside of the building to remove grime and scum. This Roemex product worked so effectively it actually made it easy for us to pressure wash the concrete with one pass.

Prior to commencing the high pressure washing operations we had to prepare and train our personnel to work safely at heights with the relevant P.P.E. and fall arresting equipment.

The work was done mainly at night as to not disturb the public during the daylight working period. This made it logistically difficult for us to operate but our personnel overcame these challenges by having spare pumps, adequate diesel and constant water supply on location to ensure the project was completed safely as projected within budget.
